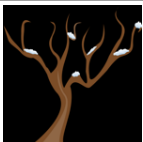

November IN THE GARDEN



1. Clear up fallen leaves
2. Raise containers onto pot legs to prevent water logging
3. Plant tulip bulbs for a spring display next year.
4. Prune roses to prevent wind-rock
5. Plant out winter bedding
6. Cover brassicas with netting if pigeons are a problem
7. Insulate outdoor containers from frost
8. Stop winter moth damage to fruit trees using grease bands around the trunk
9. Put out bird food to encourage winter birds into the garden
10. Use a seasonal bonfire to dispose of excess debris unfit for composting.

A Friendly Reminder about Road Safety!

Under the Highways Act (1980), farmers and contractors have a legal obligation to ensure their vehicles are cleared of any mud or debris before entering the public highway. Excess mud on the road is a danger to cars, motorbikes and cyclists and can change the way a vehicle handles, causing skidding, especially in wet conditions.

Superintendent Lee Davenport, Head of the Force Operations Department, Warwickshire Police and West Mercia Police said: "Every year we face problems with agricultural vehicles leaving large amounts of mud and debris on the roads during the harvest season. While the majority of farmers take steps to ensure they keep the roads clear and safe, not all are as diligent.

"We would like to remind farmers and contractors of their responsibilities under the Highways Act. We have already taken action against offenders who haven't complied with this legislation and will continue to take a tough stance against anyone who we believe is being reckless and irresponsible."

DEFIBRILLATOR REFRESHER TRAINING & COMMUNITY LUNCHEON – SAT 13 DEC – VILLAGE HALL

On Sat 13 Dec at 0930 the Stanton HeartBeat (AED) Scheme are holding a refresher training session in the Village Hall for those people who have previously trained in Basic Life Support and the use of an AED. Representatives from West Midlands Ambulance service will also take the group through the necessary paperwork to get DBS checked (the old CRB checks). Folks will need to bring passport, driving license, National Insurance number, and a utility bill or council tax bill to prove current address. Following this at 1330 members of the Parish Council's Emergency Planning Committee will hold a free community luncheon. During lunch we will discuss how, as a community, we can support each other during emergencies like the power cuts we experienced last winter.
