WHERE DID "PROUD SALOPIAN" COME FROM?

It is believed the area of Shrewsbury was settled in the 5th century by refugees from the nearby Roman City of Viroconium (Wroxeter), but the first physical evidence dates from the 7th century Saxons who named the town Scrobbesbyrig". Shrewsbury was probably founded as a town in the 8th century by the Saxon rulers of Mercia, who needed a fortified burh to control the Severn river-crossing on the

road between the burhs of Hereford and Chester. The town fell to Welsh forces led by Llywelyn the Great in 1215 and again in 1234; after both attacks the defences were greatly increased. In 1283 Edward 1 held a Parliament, the first to include a House of Commons, at Shrewsbury to decide the fate of Dafydd ap Gruffydd, the last free Welsh ruler of Wales. Dafydd was executed for high treason in Shrewsbury.

Later, after the formation of the Church of England, it is believed that the town was offered the status of cathedral city by Henry VIII, as the part of a proposed "Diocese of Shropshire". Reputedly, the citizens of the town rejected this offer, preferring to remain a "first of towns", this being the source of the term "Proud Salopian", that refers to a resident proud of Shrewsbury the way it is.
